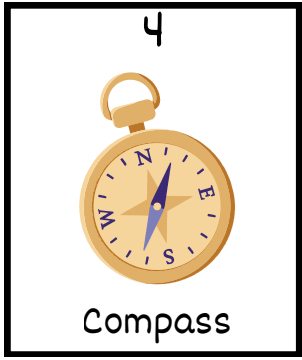
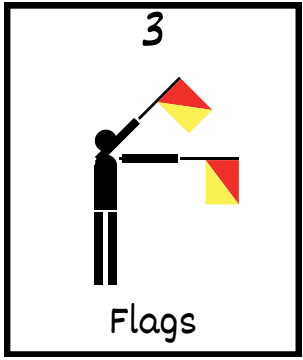
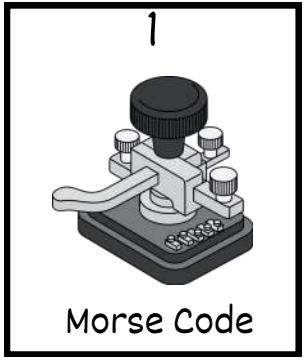


How Ships Send Messages Over Time








Look at the pictures of ways people on a ship send messages.
